

Okay, so a breakdown of curtain options, with some personal suggestions, take them or leave them, of course, with styling suggestions.

We have 4 options, all within budget, but all of which totally work with current colors in your room, and all of which will set the color scheme for anything else you'll bring in there (depending of course on how much you care). I have sort of also made a styling decision to highlight that FABULOUS brick wall you have in the room, because it hurts me not to- I can recalculate if you want me to, but it also matches the dark wood of your furniture. Here goes!

I have ordered these in increasing price, but included a rating of which I personally would choose from 1 being obviously my 1st choice, to 4, my last choice. That being said, I think they're all great.

I will say, as opposed to the picture, I would get a bronze curtain rod, rather than a silver one, regardless of which color you pick, since you have dark brown furniture.

**Color- Spiced red-** they come in a set of 2, but for comparison purposes, these come in at \$17/panel (again, the 54x84- i do think these are the right size for your window height, you have high ceilings- you should measure anyway)

I would get the Spiced Red ones, although the blue or the sage might also work- they do a good job of highlighting the brick red as well as the brown in your furniture, while still having the light blue in the background to bring in the color of your walls. As with the other set, I do suggest bronze curtain rod rather than silver. These fall for me as a 2/4.

**Color- Birds on Taupe-** they come in a set of 2, but for comparison purposes, these come in at \$19/panel (the 52x84- they're a little less wide, but again, this only affects how wide your curtain rod ends up being, which you should always buy AFTER buying curtains anyway)

I really like these in general (these and the bottom ones personally compete for #1), despite being at 3/4 on my official list, because I wasn't sure how you'd feel about birds on your curtains? They do a good job of highlighting the brick red as well as the brown in your furniture, while still having the light blue in the background to bring in the color of your walls, and just generally lighten all the heavy colors in your color pallet. Unlike the other sets, I do suggest silver curtains rod rather than bronze, it allows for the dark color on the leaves in the pattern to fluctuate visually between grey and brown. It also allows you to bring in colors like turquoise and mustard yellow, because of the color of the birds.

**Color- Orange - \$31.50 / panel (52"x84")**

I would get the Orange ones. These *are* the most expensive, but they're kind of gorgeous. Again, they do a good job of highlighting the brick red as well as the brown in your furniture, also while still having the light blue (a bit more prominent player in these ones) to bring in the color of your walls, as well as some white to bring in the moldings. As with the previous set, I do suggest silver curtain rod rather than bronze. These fall for me as a 1/4.

Let me know what you think, and which you choose! Also, **Measure your windows, dont take my guess for granted.**

**Also, hang your curtain rod 5-7" ABOVE the window frame, and make sure the curtains "puddle" slightly on the floor, to make the ceilings look taller.**

If you already knew this, please disregard. Just a precautionary measure.
